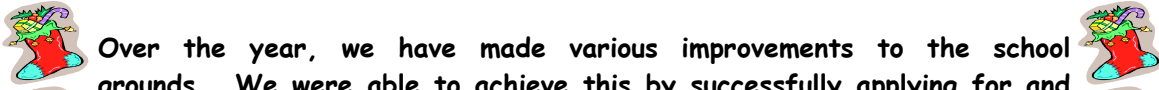

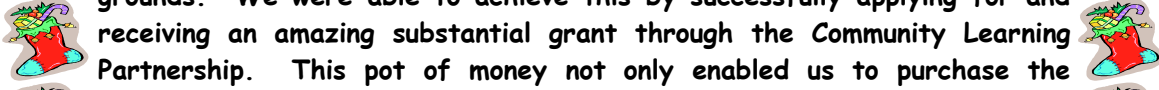
Headteacher's letter



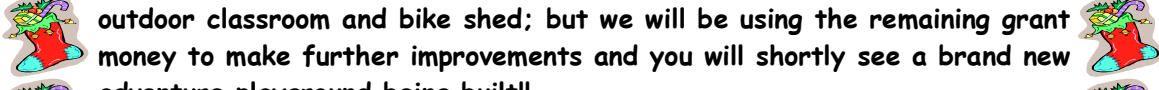

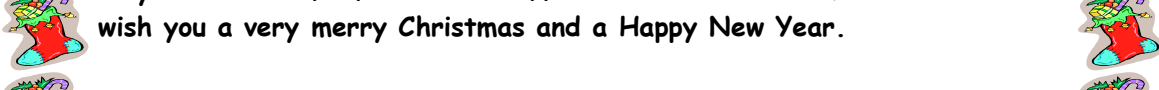
May I on behalf of all the staff and Governors at Woodseaves School wish you a very merry Christmas and a Happy New Year.
